<u>Exclusive film screening</u> of *Dark Waters* at Fogartyville on April 24th! This film highlights Rob Bilott's successful lawsuit against the multinational chemical company DuPont. Bilott is an environmental attorney from Cincinnati who has led complex cases for clients impacted by exposure to damaging per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances ("PFAS"). *Dark Waters* tells Bilotts' story of how he went under great risk to uncover the connection of unexplained deaths to one of the world's largest corporations. The film stars Mark Ruffalo as Bilott and won the award for Best Feature Film at Environmental Media Association Awards.

Following the screening, Rob Bilott will lead a conversation to discuss the work that still must be done to protect our environment from dangerous pollutants.
